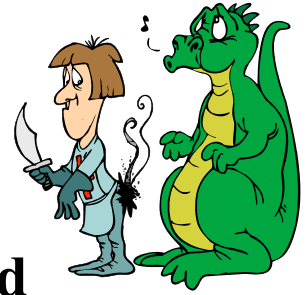

We are the New England chapter of the International Costumers' Guild (ICG), which is a worldwide organization of costume professionals and hobbyists. It is a non-profit, charitable, and educational organization designed to "promote the educational, cultural, literary, artistic, and theatrical advancement of costume design and construction, and the influence of costume (clothing), fabrics, and design upon societies and cultures." It is also designed to "promote public goodwill towards the costuming community and to provide a public forum for the discussion of costume, clothing, and other related subjects through publications, conferences, and other special projects." The ICG publishes *The ICG Newsletter*, which features articles on techniques, events, and items of interest to costumers. For more information see www.costume.org.
